FERGIE HER STRANGE BEHAVIOR

It wasn't the kind of performance Fergie usually gives. On Dec. 3 the singer attended an L.A. fund-raiser for the Trevor Project, a nonprofit that works to prevent suicides among LGBTQ youth, and surprised the audience with unscheduled antics. When Armie Hammer began introducing director and designer Tom Ford, the 42-year-old rushed the stage and interrupted him to promote her new album. "This is not a shameless promotion," she told startled onlookers before lapsing into verses from her song "A Little Work." "It got awkward fast when we realized this wasn't planned," says an observer. "Everyone in the room was uncomfortable." But a rep for Fergie, who split from husband Josh Duhamel in September, says it was simply "a gag that fell flat due to timing." The rep adds, "She's happy and healthy." - DANA ROSE FALCONE.
